The 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon has a deep cassis nose, a slightly more opaque bluish/ruby/purple color, medium to full body, good purity, sweet tannins, and an attractive texture. Drink it over the next decade or more. This is a group of solidly made, well-endowed, pure wines with rather striking electric blue labels.

2007 Blue Rock Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon – Medium to dark purple in color, this wine smells of black cherry and tobacco. In the mouth powdery tannins wrap around flavors of cherry, leather, and a hint of earthiness. Good acidity makes the wine bright, and flavors of leather and dirt linger in the finish. Nicely done.

2007 Blue Rock, Alexander Valley – Medium to medium-dark ruby; attractive, fragrant, cherry fruit aroma with hints of roasted coffee and smoked meat; medium-full to full body; toasty, smoky, cherry fruit flavors with herbal notes and hints of espresso and dark chocolate medium-full tannin; slightly tart on the finish; lingering aftertaste. Approachable now. Highly recommended.

Winemaker's Notes: Blue Rock Cabernet is blended from some of the oldest blocks from the Estate. It is aged in 50% new and 50% once used French Oak. The 2007, a luxurious vintage, is 92% Cabernet Sauvignon with smaller amounts of Cabernet Franc, Malbec, and Merlot for added texture and complexity. The wine is very aromatic with mint, blueberry and black fruits. Deep flavors of mostly black fruits are balanced with well-endowed but fine grained tannins. There is excellent balance and a very long finish. Approachable now but will improve with 10 or more years of proper cellaring. 980 cases made: Winemakers Nick Goldschmidt and Kenny Kahn
